

ELIGIBLE AND NON-ELIGIBLE e-waste

What is eligible as e-waste?

Desktop PCs	Laptop PCs
Monitors	Hard drives
Keyboards	Computer mouse
Computer power supplies	Circuit boards
Motherboards	Network and memory cards
Floppy disc and CD drives	Printers
Scanners	Photocopiers
Mobile phones	Test equipment
Fax machines	Server equipment
Components	Telephones
Answering machines	Vacuum cleaners
Microwaves	Alarm clocks
Hair dryers	Cordless Tools (Drills etc)
UPS (Uninterruptible Power Supply) units	
Televisions (except plasmas and LCDs over 55cms)	
Electronic games and toys (including joysticks and computer game consoles)	
Household and entertainment appliances (eg videos, DVD players, hi-fi equipment, stereos, speakers, digital or video cameras)	

Note: It is important that computer monitor and TV screens are not broken as this may render the item unrecyclable due to the hazard of broken glass and leaking fluids.

What is not eligible as e-waste?

Household batteries	Light globes
Fluorescent tubes	Halogen lights
Fridges	Freezers
Air conditioners	Styrofoam
Smoke detectors	
Broken computer Monitors and TV screens	
Some large plasma and LCD televisions (over 55 cms)
