The Henty Skate Park Committee has also approached Library & Youth Services Development Officer, Susan Kane to organise YAC to assist with selling raffle tickets to raise money for the park.

#### **Action:**

The committee decided Flipout Trampoline Albury as number one choice. All members agreed that the events should be free or kept to a minimal cost.
