

Expressions of Interest are invited for a Licence over Crown Land (approx. 1.6188 ha) for the purpose of grazing and situated at Lot 192 and Lot 205 DP 753342, Glenellen, known as Reserve 81633.

Term

The successful applicant will be permitted to graze stock for a period of 12 months commencing 1 November 2024 and terminating 31 October 2025.

Rental

Rent for this grazing licence must be paid annually. Applicants must submit an annual rental offer to support their application.

The statutory minimum rent for a grazing licence, as determined by the Crown Land Management Act 2016, is \$642.00 a year inclusive of GST.

If successful, an application fee applies, as provided in the Fees and Charges on Councils website.

Bush Fire Plan

Outline your bushfire prevention plan – under the Rural Fires Act 1997 landholders are required to take the necessary steps to prevent the occurrence and spread of bushfires.

Fencing

Applicants should submit their expression of interest on the basis of the property in its present state. The successful applicant will be responsible for ensuring that the fencing is maintained and kept in a stock-proof condition.

Public Liability Insurance

The successful applicant will be required to effect Public Liability Insurance for an amount not less than Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) in the joint names of the parties and furnish Council with a copy of their Certificate of Currency.
