DOORS CLOSE AT 8.15 AM

1. All exhibits must have been grown or owned by the exhibitor for a minimum two months, except in floral design and junior sections.
2. All exhibits to be displayed in bottles provided, except where stated otherwise.
3. All entries to be on flower show entry form available in this booklet.
4. Exhibitors must report to steward before placing exhibits.
5. Each exhibit must have entry ticket, to be placed under each exhibit.
6. Judging shall commence at **9.00 am**. Judges and stewards only permitted in hall during judging. Judges' decision is final.
7. Entry fee 50c per entry in all sections. Children Sections Free Entry.
8. Exhibits must not be removed from the hall until after **3.30pm** on the day of the show.
9. In the event of a tie for a prize, the eventual winner will be decided by Judge's discretion.
10. In sections with only one exhibit, first prize will not necessarily be awarded.

The stem must be at least or equal to 5cm above the bottle.

- CLASS 2.** 1 Stem Tall Bearded Iris – Red, Brown, Tan (or blends thereof)
- CLASS 3.** 1 Stem Tall Bearded Iris – Apricot, Orange, Pink (or blends thereof)
- CLASS 4.** 1 Stem Tall Bearded Iris – Yellow, White (or blends thereof)
- CLASS 5** 1 Stem Old World Iris
- CLASS 6.** 1 Stem Dutch Iris or any other Iris not listed.
- CLASS 7.** 1 Bloom Tall Bearded Iris – Purple, Mauve, Blue, Black (or blends)
- CLASS 8.** 1 Bloom Tall Bearded Iris – Red, Brown, Tan (or blends thereof)
- CLASS 9.** 1 Bloom Tall Bearded Iris – Apricot, Orange, Pink (or blends)
- CLASS 10.** 1 Bloom Tall Bearded Iris – Yellow, White (or blends thereof)

SECTION E – AUSTRALIAN FLORA

Limit 45cm above top of container

- CLASS 3.** 3 Cuts Grevillea in flower – 3 varieties – separate bottles
- CLASS 4.** 1 Cut Banksia
- CLASS 5.** 1 Cut Australian Flora Flowering
- CLASS 6.** 1 Cut Australian Flora not in flower can include buds/seed pods.
- CLASS 7.** 1 Cut Australian Flora Foliage – most unusual.
- CLASS 8.** 1 Cut Australian Flora Flower – most delicate.

Embellishments Allowed- Height not to exceed 35 cm.

CLASS 1. Table Arrangement with a candle centerpiece.

CLASS 3. Miniature Arrangement in an egg cup

CLASS 4. Arrangement in a most unusual container not a vase

SECTION G – HANGING CONTAINER (1 plant only)

SECTION I – CHILDREN 10 YEARS AND UNDER

CLASS 1. Saucer decorated with Flowers in sand.

(Saucer to be completely covered and no larger than 15cm)

CLASS 2. Vegetable person – toothpicks can be used – maximum height 25cm.

CLASS 3. Small vase of flowers

- Read your recipe and always weigh or measure ingredients accurately.
- Never use a packet cake mix - unless stated in Schedule.
- Iced means - plain, smooth icing on top of cake only, except for Fruit cakes.
- No cake crumbs should show in the icing.
- Icing should not be dripping down the sides.
