HENTY-CULCAIRN PROBUS

Henty-Culcairn Probus club met at Culcairn Bowling Club Wednesday 8th May. Our President Warren Berkery opened the meeting, and the National anthem was sung.

44 members were present, and visitors were welcomed. Robyn Lane was officially made a new member with a badge presentation. Big news is that the beanie competition has reached 600 beanies and still rising. Big reveal is on 4th June 2024 from 6pm to 7.30pm. RSVP is necessary to take part.

Our five minute speaker was Beris Klemke. Beris married Lester and they have six children, 25 grandchildren and is soon to be a Great Nana. She has been involved in her church and youth groups and has been a sheep farmer's wife and she told us lots of lovely farming stories. Warren presented Beris with our Probus pen, and we thank her for giving us all a smile with a small share in her life.

After morning tea Gary Kenney introduced us to his friend of 40 years, Dr. Penny Vine. Dr. Vine belongs to Murray Valley Sanctuary Refugee Group who have a Facebook page of that name. Dr. Vine has been working with refugees for nearly 30 years, mostly assisting people on Humanitarian visas to settle in Alburv Wodonga. She said that her work with refugees had heightened her awareness of the suffering of the aboriginal community. Many years ago, Dr. Vine, who was then working as a grief counsellor, came to Culcairn following the death in a car accident of five young people and gave us some ideas about surviving such a tragedy.

Dr. Vine has worked with parents after sudden deaths of babies and understands the trauma of mastectomy. Refugees are people who have been registered and are unable to return to country out of well-founded fear of being killed or imprisoned. These people are hoping that life could be better. We heard of water being available in displaced person camps for 2 hours, possibly and only 2 containers for water allowed.

We heard of people eventually being able to come to Australia with 202 humanitarian visas and the sponsored people having to repay air fare loans as they settle in. The funds are recycled to bring more people. These traumatised people, most often non-English speaking, with few belongings, are required to do 500 hours of English lessons, to out Centrelink paperwork for Newstart fill allowance and are required to look for work. 




